

2017 Right to Life – Livingston Essay Contest

Contest Rules

1. Eligibility: Contestants must be in grades 9-12 for the 2016/17 school year. (NOTE: Returning students may not use the same topic as last year)
2. Contestants are to research and write an original prolife essay on the issue of abortion, cloning, euthanasia, infanticide, or embryonic stem cell research.
3. Essays must be submitted/postmarked by April 6, 2017.
4. Essays shall be 800 - 1000 words in length, and word count must be noted on the essay.
5. Essays must be double-spaced with pages numbered. Font size must be no smaller than 12-point.
6. Cite any sources used. Please do not use any artwork, pictures or plastic covers
7. Please put name on each page and number the pages.
8. Essays will be judged on originality, content and accuracy.
9. Winners will be notified by April 14, 2017.
