### We Are MOVING!

It was just a few weeks ago when we sent out fliers to our best supporters, asking for help identifying places for rent in Livingston County. Our current office has seen far better days, and is requiring too much maintenance for our landlord to keep up. He admits, it's just too much repair! It was very affordable, and we had been there for years - but YES - it was time to move!

Led by our fearless leader, Kathy Ogorek, board members toured several facilities, from Brighton to Howell to Fowlerville. Some landlords really didn't want us, which we appreciated knowing up front. Some spaces were affordable, but just too small. One required too much build-out to "make it work". Another was "out back" and cave-like, requiring the taller ones to duck to avoid hitting their heads as they moved about. We prayed that God would open a door for us, and lead us to a central location where we'd have good signage and exposure, where we'd be more centrally located, and where volunteers would be comfortable and excited to come to work.

While our fearless leader was finally out of town for much deserved R & R, co-chair Ann O'Reilly rallied available board members to take a look. She had spotted a sign on Grand River near Dorr Road on a building that looked promising.



While this suite was a bit more than we wanted to spend, the location, signage (exposure) and space (3 rooms) was the best fit we had seen. The landlord (Jim) was willing to work with us.

On Monday, July 28 we signed a three year lease! 6241 Grand River Ave, Suite 200 is our new office!

While our mailing address is still Brighton (48114) - we are much closer to Howell - and only 1 mile from the Grand River I-96 WB exit by Kohl's on Grand River. Our hope is that this location will make it more feasible for supporters to volunteer a few hours each week, providing more opportunities to engage with residents in our community.

Here in Michigan, abortion is available for *any reason*, which for many of us is unthinkable. That is why we all need to take a STAND FOR LIFE.



It is a fun way for us to raise funds to help with this grave moral battle we face. The bonus is seeing those precious,






